possibly some further measures may be requisite in order to leave the new local Government thus constituted, sufficient independence of action. In this case it may become further necessary that Parliament should be consulted, a contingency which need not at present be anticipated, but for which I should wish you to be prepared, and on which I shall expect to receive from you timely information and advice.
