The sale was repudiated by claimants on the spot, and it was at last settled that for £500, they were to relinquish all title to the lands at first sold, and throw in about 5000 acres more, including some valuable timber.		(This is not a complete purchase. The payment was made to secure the consent of certain Chiefs, but negociations suspended in consequence of the war.
