"Marion" Hulk, off Kawau.] <i>August 4th, 1864.</i> [S. SAM.		
No.	Diseases.	Remarks.
3	Debility.	The sick taken on shore and very comfortably located. Prisoners enjoying themselves by fishing, exploring the island, and gathering pipies. Penekuki and Tipene still low and desponding. Water good. Provisions strictly inspected prior to issue. Prisoners orderly and satisfied.

"Marion" Hulk, off Kawau.] <i>August 5th, 1864.</i> [S. SAM.		
3	Debility.	Patients under treatment favourably progressing. Big Joe is now able to go about on crutches. Tipene and Penekuki slightly better this morning. Prisoners busily employed about the smelting-house. Provisions and water good.

2	Debility.	Three men were discharged cured this morning. Big Joe continues to recover very fast. Other patients doing well. Prisoners still employed about the smelting-house. Provisions and water good.

2	Debility.	Prisoners employed clearing timber, and erecting houses. The sick improving, though Penekuki and Tipene have not manifested signs of recovery. Provisions and water good. The natives orderly, satisfied, and comfortable.
