c Mr. W. F. Cheesman's salary was increased to £175 per annum from 1st January, 1866, and Mr. Sutherland's to £150 per annum from same date.

d In February, 1865, Mr. J. E. Smith was appointed District Registrar of Land, with a salary of £100 per annum, and undertook temporarily the duties of Secretary to the Registrar-General of Land. He also received fees as Registrar of Births, Deaths, and Marriages, amounting to £100 in the year. From 1st December, 1865, Mr. Smith's salary as District Registrar was increased from £100 to £150 per annum, he continuing to perform the duty of Secretary to Reg. Gen. of Land.
