PROGRESS REPORT OF THE NEW ZEALAND WAR MEDAL COMMISSIONER.

To His Excellency Sir GEORGE FERGUSON BOWEN, G.C.M.G., &c., &c.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY,—

In accordance with the instructions conveyed by the Commission of the 1st July, 1871, I have now the honor to forward, for your Excellency's consideration, the enclosed Nominal Rolls A, B, and C, containing the names of applicants for the New Zealand War Medal, which have been referred to me, and on the justice of which I have decided, up to present date, and since the publication of my last Report dated 13th December, 1871.

In Roll A are included the names of officers and men of the Colonial Forces who claim the Medal for services rendered prior to the 31st December, 1866.

Roll B contains the names of those claiming the Medal for services performed subsequent to the 31st December, 1866.

Roll C contains the names of deceased officers and men of the Colonial Forces, on whose behalf application has been made for the Medal by their representatives.

I therefore submit this as a Progress Report for your Excellency's consideration.
