Returns to an Order of the House of Representatives, 19th September, 1872.

- I.—Return showing the Quantity of all Flour, Wheat, Oats, and Oatmeal, the produce of New Zealand, Shipped from one Province to another, stating the Ports whence Shipped and where Received, for the Year ended 30th June, 1872.
- II.—Return of the Quantities and Value of all Timber, Posts, Rails, Palings, and Shingles; Cured Bacon, Hams, Pork, Beef, and Mutton; Butter, Cheese, and Potatoes, the Produce of New Zealand, Shipped from one Province to another, stating the Ports whence Shipped and where Received, for the Year ended 30th June, 1872.
- III.—Return showing the Number and Tonnage of all Vessels built in the Colony during the Year ended 30th June, 1872, distinguishing Steam from Sailing Vessels, and the Provinces in which they were built. Also, the Number, Tonnage, and Number of Crews of the said Vessels engaged in the Coasting Trade of the Colony on the 30th June, 1872; together with the Number, Tonnage, and Number of Crews of any Foreign Vessels now engaged in the Coasting Trade.
