Fort Galatea and Taupo Road.—Formation, 8 chains; embankment, 2 chains.

Te Teko and Richmond Road.—It was found necessary to dig a drain from the Okauneke Swamp into the Tarawera River, in order to take the water off the road, which was perfectly inundated, there being no outlet. A ditch, 21 chains long and 5 feet x 4 feet, has been made, and 10 chains of fascines laid on the road, and 917 cubic yards filled in on the fascines; the earth had to be conveyed by canoe for a considerable distance. Embankment, 7 chains 462 cubic yards; one box culvert, 18 feet × by 18 feet, has also been made; one bridge culvert, 16 feet long × 15 feet wide; four stringers, 12 feet × 4 feet; two cills, 9 feet \times 4 feet; and four piles, 9 feet \times 9 feet; hand-rails and braces. The cills and stringers are fastened to the piles with iron bolts. The culverts and bridges have been repaired on the Titiwaroa Swamp; the totara 2-inch planking being found to be too light for a heavy dray to pass over, it has been replaced with 3-inch plank.

A portion of the timber for the bridges on Te Teko and Whakatane Road has been cut.

bridges will be built as soon as all the material is ready.

I attach a Schedule with full details of the work performed; it will appear small when contrasted with my return of last year, but this will be accounted for by the fact that no men have been employed on the works since January, in consequence of the detachment being in Wellington.
