Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, No. 14, 1877, 2nd August, 1877.

Ordered, "That a return be laid upon the table of all revenues accrued under the Native Lands Acts during each of the years 1872, 1873, 1874, and 1875, and specifically referred to in sections 7, 7, 10, and 6 of the Appropriation Acts of those years, showing the amount accrued in each province of the North Island during each of those years."—(*Mr. Travers.*)
