The charges that I have made for what the "Hinemoa" has done are less than one half of what the Government would have had to pay if they had chartered steamers to do any of the work that the "Hinemoa" has done.

When the Government wanted to charter a steamer to take the Governor from Wellington to Lyttelton the New Zealand Steam Shipping Company asked £700, and I could name many other

The "Hinemoa" steamed 15,235 miles, was under steam 1,680 hours, and used 964 tons of coal,

which is 11 cwt. 27 lbs. of coal per hour.

The "Hinemoa" has used 100 tons of Bay of Islands coal, which was only equal to about 70 tons of Newcastle coal.

In twelve months the "Luna" cost £8,200, steamed 18,000 miles, and used 1,800 tons of coal. S.S. "Hinemoa," Wellington, 30th June, 1877. JOHN FAIRCHILD.
