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# NATIVE SCHOOLS IN THE MIDDLE ISLAND

(RETURN OF).

*Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated 14th June, 1882.*

“That there be laid upon the table a return showing the names of the places where there are Native schools in the Middle Island, and the amount of salaries paid to the schoolmasters.”—(*Mr. Taiaroa.*)

THERE are twelve Native schools in the Middle Island. The following is a list of the places, with the rate per annum of the teachers' salaries in each case:—
