detail, the Senate has not yet been able to confer the degrees and scholarships gained during the past year, but from a telegraphic communication it appears that the following numbers will be added to the roll of the University, at a special meeting to be held for the purpose on the receipt of the reports referred to:—To the degree of Master of Arts, four Bachelors of Arts; to the degree of Bachelor of Arts, seventeen undergraduates; to the degree of Bachelor of Laws, two Bachelors of Arts; five Senior Scholars; eight Junior Scholars.

The number of graduates after examination on the roll of the University, with the above additions, will be as follows:—Masters of Arts, 22; Bachelors of Arts of two years' standing, 18; Bachelors of Arts of less than two years' standing, 29; total, 69. The number of undergraduates at present on the

roll of the University is 289.
