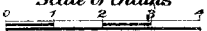
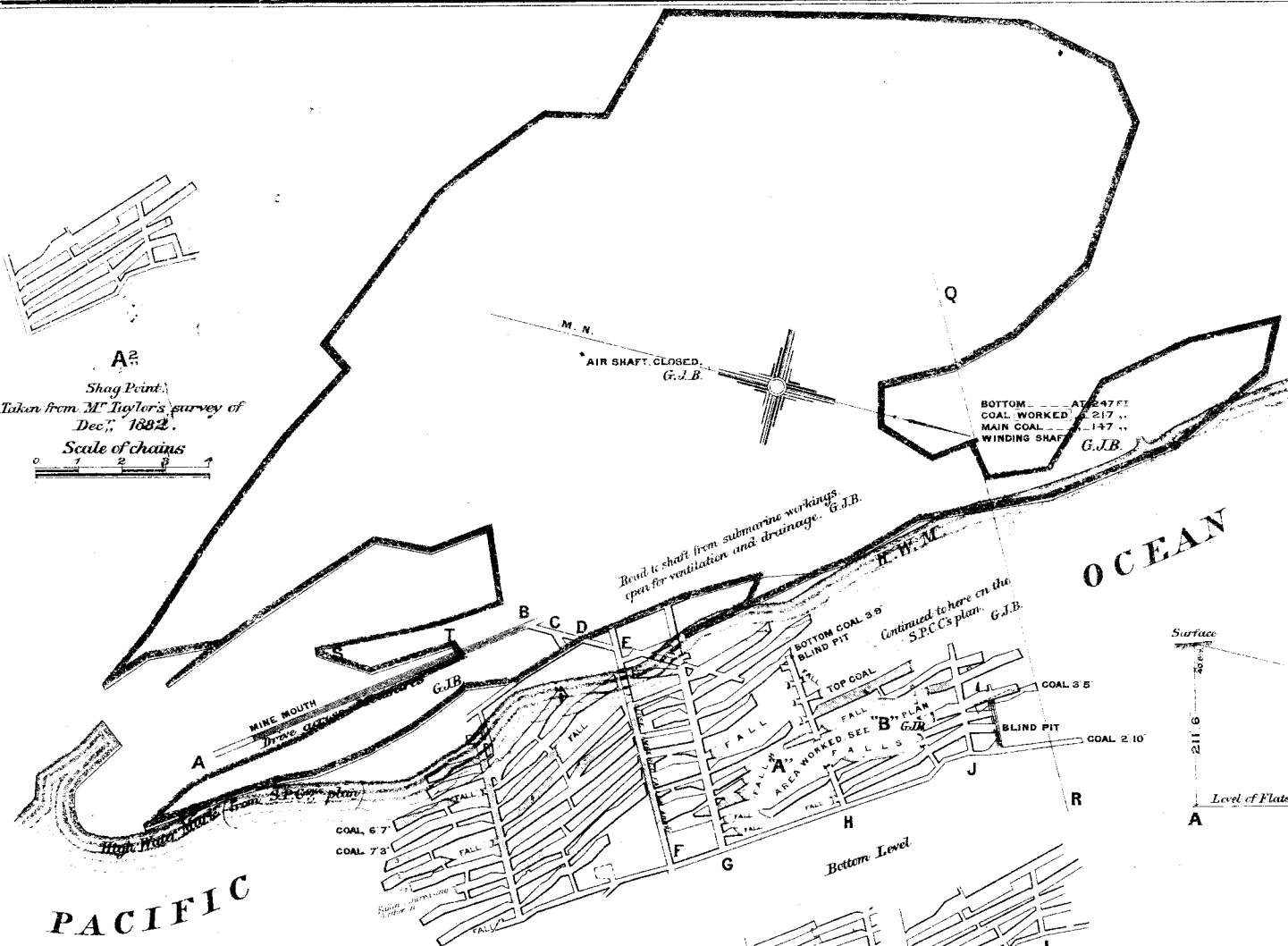


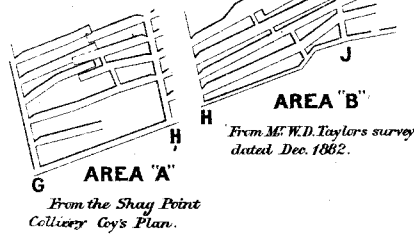

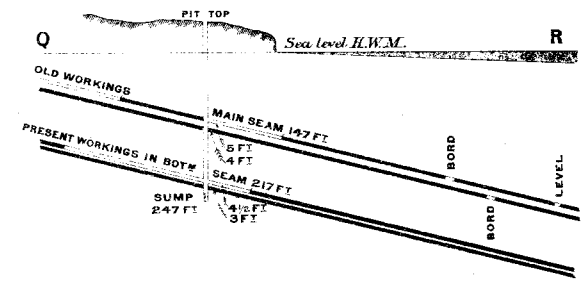


Scale of chains.



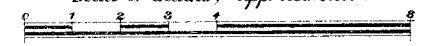
SECTION ON LINE Q. R.

 By G.J. Binns.

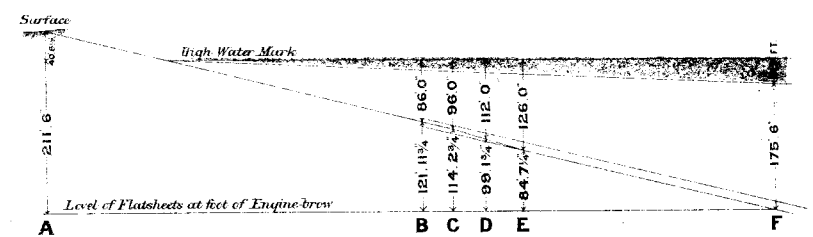
