has been collected, £87 13s. 8d. has been written off as unrecoverable on an unsatisfied judgment of the Courts, and £149 11s. 4d. is still outstanding. The defaulters are chiefly in the Gisborne District, where tenants have possibly undertaken to pay too much for their farms.

The statement of the accounts for the past year, duly audited, is enclosed herewith.
