SALARIES, ETC., PAID AT PRINCIPAL LUNATIC ASYLUMS IN THE COLONY.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated 7th July, 1886.

Ordered, "That a return be laid upon the table of this House, in connection with the principal lunatic asylums at Seacliff, Sunnyside, Wellington, and Auckland, showing (1) the salaries paid in cash to the several attendants; (2) the ration allowance to each; (3) the resident or cottage accommodation afforded to each; and (4) the uniform allowance, if any. Also a similar return for the principal gaols of Dunedin, Lyttelton, Wellington, and Auckland, giving similar information respecting each of the warders at these gaols."—MR. O'CALLAGHAN.
