(b.) DUTIES of OFFICERS of the HOUSE of REPRESENTATIVES and GENERAL ESTABLISHMENT.

Clerk, during Session—Records all proceedings of the House; signs all orders of the House; endorses Bills, and writes all messages to the Legislative Council; prepares and corrects the Order Paper; has the custody of all records and documents belonging to the House; is generally responsible for the regulation of matters connected with the business of the House; assists the Speaker and members in regard to questions of order and proceedings of the House. Also performs the duties of Clerk of Parliaments, which consist chiefly in the final preparation and comparing of Bills after they have passed both Houses, endorsing the same, and laying them before the Governor for the Royal assent.

During Recess—Supervises preparation and printing of Journals and Appendices, and conducts any correspondence that may occur connected with the business of the House; has certain duties in connection with the Regulation of Elections Act; passes and approves accounts for payment.
