REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS ON LAND GRANTED TO MAORIS

(RETURN OF CASES OF), FROM 1ST APRIL, 1885, TO 31ST MARCH, 1886.

Laid on the Table by the Hon. Mr. Ballance, with the Leave of the House.

RETURN of CASES in which RESTRICTIONS on ALIENATION in or indorsed on Grants of Land to Maoris have been REMOVED by the Governor, from 1st April, 1885, to 31st March, 1886.

The last-mentioned reserve contained their houses, &c. This arrangement was carried out, and a portion of the Awahuri Reserve purchased and vested in the Public Trustee. The notice of the Governor's intention to remove the restrictions was gazetted in the usual way in April, 1884	J. Whisker.

Exchanged for other land, in accordance with a promise made in 1873. The deed, with the Governor's consent, is retained in the Native Office pending the completion of the deed of trust vesting the land exchanged in the Public Trustee	Waana Gage.
