Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated 20th July, 1886.

Ordered, "That there be laid upon the table a return showing, in detail, the amount paid to Professor Black and others for lecturing at the principal mining centres of the colony, and the travelling expenses in each case, under the vote of £1,750 granted for that purpose last year; also a statement, as far as practicable, of how it is proposed to expend the vote of £4,000, submitted for the same purpose this year."—(MR. HAMLIN.)
