EDUCATION RESERVES.

The reports and accounts of the several bodies of School Commissioners follow those of the Education Boards in the Appendix (p. 87). The income of the Commissioners for the year amounted to £41,854 11s. 1d. Out of this sum they paid £1,707 9s. 1d. to the authorities of secondary schools, and £31,694 8s. 7d. to the Education Boards. This last amount, though paid to local Boards, was received by them as an advance for which they had to account, and is balanced by a corresponding reduction in the payments made to them by the department. Table S is a summary of the accounts of the Commissioners.
