Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated 27th August, 1890.

Ordered. "That a return, showing the annual rainfall at Auckland, Wellington, Napier, New Plymouth, Hokitika, Canterbury, and Dunedin, from the date at which observations were first commenced to the year 1889 inclusive, be laid before this House."—Hon. Sir J. HALL.
