the amounts of interest paid, and by whom. Other than house accounts all bills are passed for payment at a monthly meeting of the trustees, and at such meeting a cheque for each account is drawn and signed by two trustees. At each monthly meeting the receipts and expenditure for the previous month are audited by the trustees, and the receipts for all moneys paid are produced to and examined by them. In addition to the above, the receipts and expenditure account for each month is audited by a paid auditor.
