8. The persons who attended term lectures in 1891 were 156—viz., ninety-two male and sixty-four female. Of these, the graduates were four—viz., three male and one female; undergraduates, fifty-one—viz., thirty male and twenty-one female; and non-matriculated students, 101—viz., fifty-nine male and forty-two female. The attendants at term lectures in the previous year were 147—viz., sixty-three male and eighty-four female. Of these, the graduates were four—viz., three male and one female; undergraduates, forty-six—viz., twenty-nine male and seventeen female; and non-matriculated students, ninety-seven—viz., thirty-one male and sixty-six female.

9. Occasional lectures of a more popular character on scientific subjects have been delivered,

and have been numerously attended.
