LIEUT.-COLONEL FOX

(RETURN OF PARTICULARS AS TO ENGAGEMENT OF, COST OF REPORT BY, ETC.).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated 5th July, 1893.

Ordered, "That a return be laid before this House showing—(1) The length of time Lieut.-Colonel Fox was in the service of the colony before he completed his report on the defences; (2) the amount of his salary, travelling-expenses, and allowances during that time; (3) what the report mentioned has cost the colony to have produced; (4) the terms of any agreement that has been entered into with Lieut.-Colonel Fox."—(Mr. PALMER.)
