^{*} Previous to the financial year 1895-96 it was the practice for many of the Government departments to pay the Railway Department for tickets, and for all the Government departments to pay freights for parcels and goods. Thus, for the year 1895-96, the Postal, Education, Police, and Defence Departments made payments to the Railway Department for services not previously charged for, while the Railway Department similarly made payments for postal and telegraph facilities. The amount for 1895-96 credited to the Railway Department is on this account larger than in previous years. This is alluded to in the first page of the New Zealand Railways Statement for 1896, where it is shown that the net amount of £18,428 has been added to the railway revenue as net payments by Government departments for services, which services were not previously paid for.
