## "THE UNIVERSITY ENDOWMENT ACT, 1868."

The income from reserves made under "The University Endowment Act, 1868," does not go to the University of New Zealand, but is accumulating in the Treasury, and must continue to do so until the General Assembly decides to what purpose of higher education it is to be devoted. The amount in hand at the end of 1895 was £3,061 18s. 5d., as follows: From reserves in Canterbury, £1,213 2s. 4d.; in Westland, £200 2s. 6d.; in Taranaki, £1,648 13s. 7d. No rent has as yet been received on account of the Waitotara (Wellington) reserve.
