PERMANENT ARTILLERY

(APPOINTMENTS TO THE), AND TRANSFERS TO THE POLICE FORCE, FROM THE 1ST JANUARY, 1883,
TO THE 1ST JANUARY, 1890.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 4th November, 1897.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The number of men appointed to the Permanent Artillery from the 1st January, 1883, to the 1st January, 1890, both dates inclusive; (2) the districts in which such persons were residing at the date of their appointment; (3) the names of persons transferred from the Permanent Artillery to the Police Force during the above-mentioned period, also the length of service previous to their transfer to the Police Force."—(MR. MILLS.)
