In another paper (E.-5) are shown the results of examinations conducted in the colony on behalf of the Science and Art Department, London, and of the City and Guilds of London Institute.

SECONDARY SCHOOLS.

The reports of the secondary schools are given in a separate paper (E.-12). Their income for 1898 from school fees, not including fees for boarding, was £24,345; from rents and interest, £24,780; and from endowments administered by School Commissioners, £2,322. The pupils on the rolls in the last quarter of the year were 2,706.

Table Z contains some of the principal statistics relating to these schools.
