PARTICULARS AS REGARDS STUDENTS AND SCHOLARSHIPS.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated 12th July, 1899.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing the number of students attending the University Colleges of Auckland, Christchurch, and Dunedin during the three years ended 31st November, 1898; also the number of students who were residents of Auckland, Christchurch, and Dunedin, or suburbs; also the number of scholarships held by students attending the University Colleges, and number of scholarships held by those who were resident in Auckland, Christchurch, and Dunedin, or suburbs."—(Mr. McLEAN.)
