## "THE GOVERNMENT VALUATION OF LAND ACT, 1896"

(PARTICULARS AS REGARDS VALUATIONS UNDER).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated 26th October, 1898.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return giving the following particulars: (1) The principal local authorities upon which claims have been made for one-third cost of valuation under 'The Government Valuation of Land Act, 1896'; (2) the proportion of such claims referable to (a) cost of Valuers, (b) cost of Supervising Valuers, (c) office charges, (d) any other expenses; (3) the capital value, as assessed under the Act, in each of the districts of the several principal local authorities; (4) the total cost of the valuations so in part charged to the principal local authorities; (5) the balance of the total cost charged to other local authorities; (6) the grand total, showing the cost of the valuations to date of assessment."—(Mr. G. HUTCHISON.)
