NORTH ISLAND MAIN TRUNK RAILWAY LOAN

(PARTICULARS RELATIVE TO LAND PURCHASED OUT OF THE).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated 28th October, 1898.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing the number of acres of land purchased out of the North Island Trunk Railway Loan raised under the Act of 1882: also (1) the present approximated value of such land; (2) the number of acres (if any) which have been sold; (3) the amount of money received therefor; and (4) the purposes or accounts to which such moneys have been paid."—(Mr. MASSEY.)
