Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The number of scholars attending the high schools of the colony who had not passed the Fourth Standard; (2) the number who had not passed the Third Standard; and (3) the number who had not passed the Second Standard of the syllabus of our primary schools at the time of their admission into the high schools: this return to be for the year ending the 31st December, 1898."—(Mr. Meredith.)
