REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF TAXES UPON THE ADMINISTRATION OF PART IV OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, 1938, FOR THE TWELVE MONTHS ENDED 31st MARCH, 1941.

Presented to both Houses of the General Assembly pursuant to the Provisions of the Social Security Act, 1938.

## REPORT.

1 have the honour to present herewith a report upon operations carried out by the Land and Income Tax Department during the financial year ended the 31st March, 1941, in the administration of the provisions of Part IV of the Social Security Act, 1938, relating to the assessment, collection, and recovery of the social security contribution, consisting of—

- (a)  $\Lambda$  registration fee; and
- (b) A charge of is, in the pound on salaries and wages, and also on other income.

All income is subject to a further charge of 1s, in the pound for national security tax, imposed by Part II of the Finance Act, 1940, but figures relating to collections under that Act are not included in this report.

The Department's activities throughout the year have been carried out under difficult conditions arising through increased work and the release of a considerable number of experienced members of the staff for service with the armed forces.

The Post and Telegraph Department continued its valuable assistance as agent in the collection of the registration fee and of the social security charge, and in dealing with various other requirements incidental thereto

The result of the Department's operations during the year is shown by statements (a), (b), and (c) hereunder.
