Sir,-

We report that we have completed the audit of the accounts of the East Coast Native Trust Lands for the year ended 30th June, 1943, and attach hereto a set of the foregoing accounts.

We have the following comments to make:-

Freehold Property. We have not inspected the title deeds relative to the properties of the Trust, but have accepted certificates from the mortgagees namely, the District Public Trustee and the State Advances Corporation—that they are holding certain documents as security for advances. The solicitors to the Trust have certified that they are holding on behalf of the East Coast Commissioner the documents relating to the properties of the Trust which are not subject to mortgage.

Stock.—We have accepted the numbers and values of live-stock on stations as at 30th June, 1943, as certified by the Farm-managers and Mr. H. Syme, the Farm Supervisor.

Distributions. Distributions are no longer being made by the Tairawhiti District Land Board and are now being paid direct from the East Coast Commissioner's office. We have verified all payments in connection with distributions made during the year ended 30th June, 1943.
