Presented to both Houses of the General Assembly pursuant to the Provisions of the Social Security Act, 1938

REPORT

I have the honour to present herewith a report upon operations carried out by the Land and Income Tax Department during the financial year ended 31st March, 1944, in the administration of the provisions of Part IV of the Social Security Act, 1938, relating to the assessment, collection, and recovery of the social security contribution, consisting of

(a) A registration fee; and

(b) A charge of 1s. in the pound on salaries and wages and also on other income.

All income is subject to a further charge for national security tax imposed by Part II of the Finance Act (No. 2), 1942, but figures relating to collections under that Act are not included in this report.

The Post and Telegraph Department continued its valuable assistance as agent in the collection of the registration fee and of the social security and national security charge.

The result of the Department's operations during the year is shown by statements (a), (b), and (c) hereunder:
