The Canteen Board's business is conducted on commercial lines, which permit of the profits indicated being earned. This profit accrues for the benefit of Service personnel, and the undistributed portion provides the Board with working capital, thus enabling it to operate without assistance from Government or other sources.

The Board's low-selling-price policy confers many direct benefits in addition to the distribution of profit referred to above. No portion of canteen profit is paid to Government or other funds.

It is claimed that the Canteen Board's organization has provided a high standard of service to the Armed Forces in all areas in which it has been called upon to operate, and conventional necessities have been made available at reasonable prices.

The Board has established and enjoys the best of relations with the commercial community.
