The ferry service across the Piako River at Kaihere has been continuously maintained.

### Pump-Station

The drainage-pumping-station serving the Kerepeehi Blocks operated for 2231 hours in June, July, August, September, and October.

# SURVEYS AND OFFICE WORK

Engineering surveys carried out on the Hauraki Plains during the year required 23 miles 23 chains of levels, 2 miles 75 chains of traverse lines, and the taking of 92 cross sections.

The clerical staff of the Kerepeehi office is responsible for the preparation of vouchers and fortnightly payment of wages and contract-moneys, ordering and distribution of stores, and the accounts and works costs connected with drainage and land-development operations on the Hauraki Plains and Waihi Drainage Districts.
