(a) Board and lodging allowances at award rates are necessary to supplement the rates of pay received during the training period. The allowances are recoverable at any time the trainees are engaged on constructional work charged to housing loan accounts.

(b) This expenditure is under the control of the Department of Agriculture, by whom the additional estimate is submitted. £8,000 provided on main estimates.
