The expenses of many officers on transfer have increased owing to the difficulty in obtaining houses. (d) £6,000 provided on main estimates. (e) £1,650 provided on main estimates. The cost of construction of new pontoon is greater than anticipated. (f) £269 provided on main estimates. Further provision is necessary to enable the work to be completed.
