STATISTICAL SCHEDULES AND TABLES

- Table A.—Contains particulars of the properties purchased by negotiation for the settlement of ex-servicemen and of which possession was taken during the period 1st April, 1946, to 31st March, 1947.
- Table B.—Contains particulars of the properties capable of subdivision into two or more units which were acquired under section 51 of the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943, during the period 1st April, 1946, to 31st March, 1947.
- Table C.—Contains particulars of the properties acquired under Part II of the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943, during the period 1st April, 1946, to 31st March, 1947.
- Table D.—Shows the total number of units and cost of acquisition of singleunit properties acquired under section 51 of the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943, during the period 1st April, 1946, to 31st March, 1947, and the properties acquired under this legislation from 1st April, 1944, to 31st March, 1947.
- Table E.—Contains details of the actual expenditure during the year under annual appropriations on the purchase of land and improvements and on development and farming operations. Corresponding figures for the previous year are included.
- Table F.—Shows the amount of profits and losses ascertained during the period 1st April, 1946, to 31st March, 1947, on the disposal of blocks.

Statistical Schedules.—These schedules contain more particular detail and information in respect of the blocks at present under development.

All the blocks, except the Molesworth Run (Marlborough), which is still subject to the Land Laws Amendment Act, 1929, are now subject to the Small Farms Act, 1932–33.

Such blocks as have been specially purchased or acquired for the settlement of ex-servicemen have their names printed in bold type.

The statistical data covers only areas which have actually been farmed and under development by the Department for a full year as at 31st March, 1947.
