SECTION B.—THE CONFERENCE

Article 71

Composition

- 1. The Conference shall consist of all the Members of the Organization.
- 2. Each Member shall have one representative in the Conference and may appoint alternates and advisors to its representative.
- 3. No representative in the Conference may represent more than one Member.

Article 72

Voting

Alternative A.

- 1. Each Member shall have one vote in the Conference.
- 2. Except as otherwise provided in this Charter, decisions of the Conference shall be taken by a majority of the Members present and voting.

Alternative B.

- 1. Each Member shall have in the Conference the number of votes allocated to it in pursuance of the provisions of Annex ... to this Charter.
- 2. Except as otherwise provided in this Charter, decisions of the Conference shall be taken by a simple majority of the votes cast.

Alternative C.

- 1. Each Member shall have one vote in the Conference.
- 2. Except as otherwise provided in this Charter, decisions of the Conference shall be taken by a majority of the Members present and voting; *Provided* that, at the instance of any Member, any decision reached by the Organization on the matters provided for in Articles ..² shall require corroboration by a second vote taken by a simple majority of the votes cast in accordance with the plan of weighted voting set out in Annex ..¹ to this Charter.

Article 72.
