(a) The Act provides for the payment to the Taranaki Maori Trust Board of an annual sum of £5,000 as compensation for confiscation of certain Maori lands.

(b) The Act provides for the following payments to the Tainui Maori Trust Board in settlement of all claims and demands in respect of, or arising out of, the confiscation of certain lands in the Waikato District: (1) an annual payment of £5,000; (2) an additional annual payment of £1,000 for a period of forty-five years and no longer.
