## LOAN COLLECTIONS

Special collections of books on specific subjects, issued for two months, were again popular. Subjects such as gardening, occupations and hobbies, music, and New Zealand were in demand, but some libraries asked for collections on such less generally popular subjects as philosophy, mining methods and coal, and vocational guidance.

In addition to the 327 collections issued to 78 libraries linked with this Service, 21 collections were sent to teachers' training colleges, W.E.A. summer schools, Education Department refresher courses, and to other libraries outside the Service which required them for special purposes:—
