THE PUBLIC ESTATE

(PARTICULARS OF).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 18th July, 1899.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return setting forth particulars of the public estate as follows : (1) Area of land alienated from the Crown ; (2) area of Crown land acquired but not alienated ; (3) area of land held by Native owners ; (4) area of Native land leased to Europeans ; (5) quantity of land held under different tenures ; (6) extent of freehold land, with original and present unimproved value ; (7) extent of leasehold lands, with original and present values ; (8) area and number of grazing-runs and small runs respectively ; (9) rental and estimated value of the same ; (10) number of freehold and leasehold sections disposed of, and number of the same that are occupied."—(Mr. Hogg.)
