“NEW ZEALAND STATE FORESTS ACT, 1885”
(PARTICULARS RELATIVE TO PLANTATIONS UNDER THE).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 10th July, 1901.

Ordered, “That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The total area planted with forest trees up to the 31st March, 1900, under the provisions of ‘The New Zealand State Forests Act, 1885,’ or any other Act; (2) the total cost of such planting; (3) the area, if any, which has been destroyed by fire or otherwise; (4) the present estimated value of such plantations; and (5) the amount proposed to be expended on forest-tree planting during the present year.”—(Mr. FLATMAN.)
