Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 4th October, 1901.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing separately the articles now on the free list, and which have been placed on the free list, under the headings of "Agricultural Machinery" and "Agricultural Implements," from the passing of the Customs and Excise Duties Act of last year up to the present date."—(Mr. MASSEY.)
