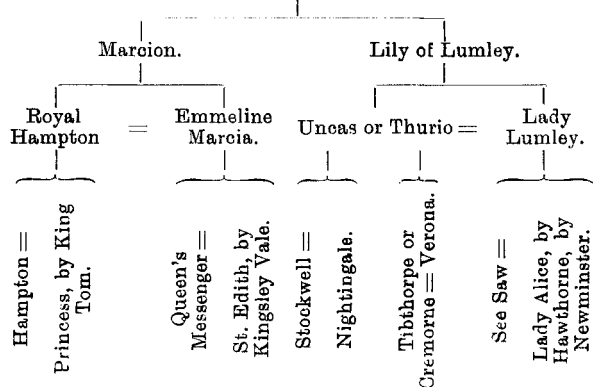
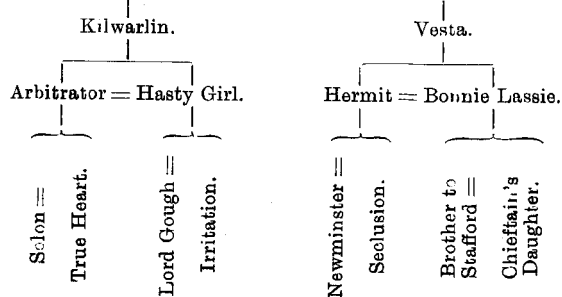

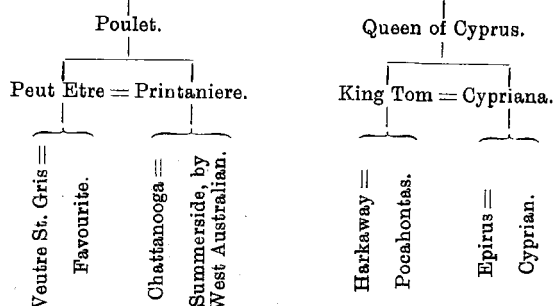

MALACHI (1893), (Black Horse).



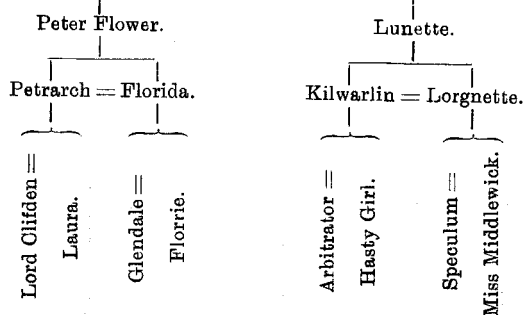

"Red Lord XXVII," by "Red Lord" (73373), is out of "Orange Blossom XIII," a cow by "Royal Nottingham" (a son of the noted cow "Molly Millicent," which was awarded first prize at the Royal Agricultural Society Show three years in succession, and one champion). "Orange Blossom XIII" has now (13th March, 1901) calved about ten weeks, and is giving 33lb. to 35lb. of milk daily. The sire "Red Lord" was awarded first prize at the Liverpool Show, 1898, and his sire, "Oxford Marquis," on first and special at E. Somerset Show, second at Frome, and third at Somerset County Show.
