Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The names of the firms or companies who executed Imperial orders for oats through the Government of this colony, referred to in B.-6, Deposit Account, and amounting to £117,773 8s., and in Gazette No. 76, page 1669, and amounting to £103,333 4s.; (2) what price per bushel f.o.b. was paid for the different orders so executed; and (3) the names of the several ports of shipment."—
