ORDER OF REFERENCE.

Extract from the Journals of the House of Representatives.

FRIDAY, THE 18TH DAY OF JULY, 1902.

Ordered, "That a Select Committee, consisting of sixteen members, be appointed, to whom shall be referred the Government Railways Superannuation Fund Bill, five to be a quorum; the Committee to consist of Mr. Collins, Mr. Fisher, Mr. Fowlds, Mr. W.
