Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 23rd September, 1902.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing separately (1) the number of estates acquired by the Government under the compulsory clauses of the Land for Settlements Act; (2) the amount paid by the Government for each estate; (3) the amount formerly paid by each estate by way of land-tax; (4) the amount paid for surveying, roading, and other expenses connected with each estate; (5) the number of tenants at present residing on each estate; and (6) the amount of rent that has been paid by the tenants of each estate."—(Mr. Lang.)
