RATE STRUCK IN EACH COUNTY IN EXCESS OF
RATE PREVIOUSLY LEVIABLE.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated the 30th June, 1904.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a Return showing the increased amount of rate struck for the current financial year in each county in excess of the rate leviable previous to the passing of 'The Counties Act Amendment Act, 1903.'"—(Mr. BUCHANAN.)

A RATE in excess of the rate leviable previous to the passing of "The Counties Act Amendment Act, 1903," has been struck in the following counties :—

County.	Excess of Rate previously leviable.
Hutt	One farthing.
Piako	One farthing.
Pohangina	Nine-fourteenths of a penny.
Taiari	One farthing.
Tauranga	One farthing.

In nineteen counties the rate for the current year has yet to be struck.
