The total number of pupils on the rolls in the last term or quarter of the year was 2,467 boys and 1,593 girls, as against 2,265 boys and 1,457 girls at the end of 1904.

CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATIONS.

The Civil Service Examinations were conducted by the Education Department—the Junior Examination in December, 1905, and the Senior Examination simultaneously with the examinations for teachers' certificates, in January, 1906.
